Our optional Blue Self-Cleaning, Solar Control double glazing combines the revolutionary benefits of a self-cleaning coating with the solar control performance of a subtle-blue tinted glass. In summer months, glass with solar control can help prevent heat build-up by reducing the amount of heat that passes through your conservatory roof.

Blue Self-Cleaning, Solar Control double glazing regulates the heat allowed in and out of your conservatory roof, so that you can enjoy a more comfortable environment all year round.

Self-cleaning glass frequently asked questions

What is self-cleaning glass?

Blue Self-Cleaning, Solar Control Glass has a unique dual-action coating that works firstly by using daylight to break down organic dirt (such as bird droppings) then using rain to wash the dirt away.

Will my roof ever need cleaning?

We cannot say that your roof will never need cleaning — that depends on the amount of dirt and rain the glass receives. It will reduce the amount of maintenance required. If cleaning is necessary, it will be less frequent and much easier than with conventional glass.

Does it work on cloudy days or during the night?

Blue Self-Cleaning, Solar Control Glass needs only a small amount of UV radiation to activate the coating — so it is always working, even on overcast days and throughout the night.

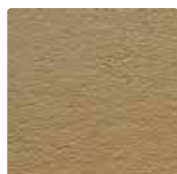
